

Operator licensing for vans

It now seems entirely likely that vans will be coming into scope of operator licensing through European law in the next few years. Logistics UK is fighting through its permanent presence in Brussels to reduce the impact of the proposals, but hire and reward van operators who move goods internationally will almost certainly be required to hold an operator licence.



Smart tachographs

Next generation 'smart' tachographs will be mandatory in all new vehicles. Vehicle operators will need to get ready before then, particularly those companies with a tachograph workshop, or when they make vehicle procurement decisions. Logistics UK can keep you up-to-date.

Traffic Commissioners are increasingly looking for evidence at licence renewal of how transport managers and directors of standard and restricted licences are keeping their knowledge up to date. We want to make sure all our members recognise compliance within their operation – this is of upmost importance.






Be Confident

Our Freight Councils offer members the opportunity to get actively involved in influencing Logistics UK's policy agenda.

Regional Freight Councils meet in 13 locations across the UK. There are also Air, Road, Rail and Water Councils that all members can join, as well as Shippers Council for cargo owners (retailers, manufacturers and wholesalers), a Strategic Council to address long-term issues, and a further 10 working groups focusing on more detailed logistics issues, such as customs, environmental footprint and access to skills.

These are complemented by regular Webinars and web-meetings to provide information and gather member views on fast-moving issues.

Logistics UK is also represented at the highest levels of EU logistics policy through its office in Brussels, European Commission advisory groups and trade bodies such as the European Logistics Platform.
