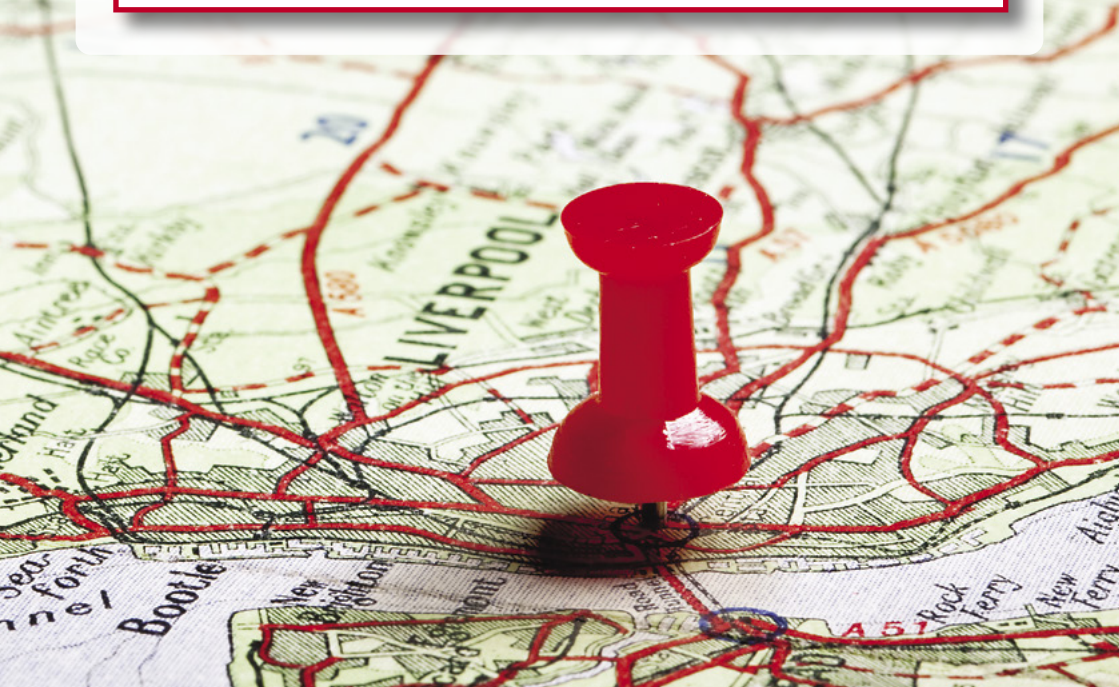
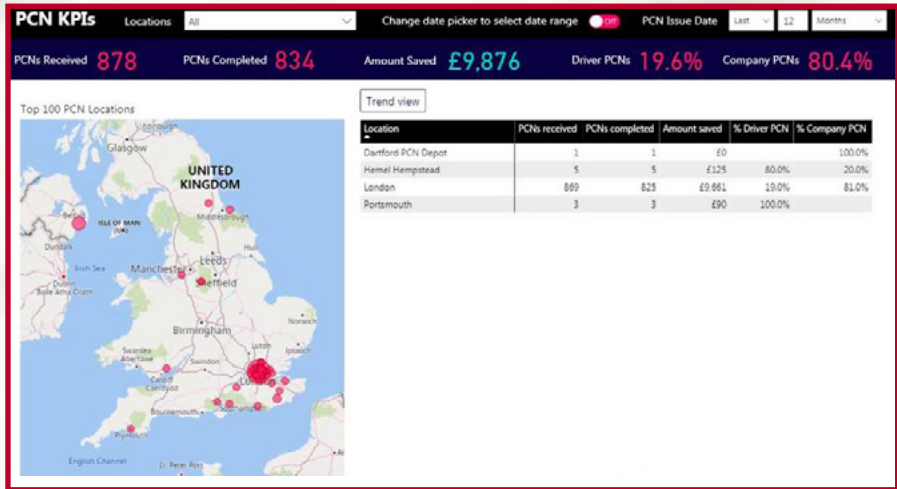

This may mean rescheduling deliveries, training drivers or working with the authority in question to overcome the challenges that lead to PCNs being issued.
