The absence rates of skilled workers across many sectors of the UK economy continue to soar thanks to the highly transmissible Omicron variant of COVID-19. Logistics UK is giving regular feedback to the Department for Transport (DTf) to update it on how the absences are impacting on the logistics sector. During these discussions, Logistics UK raised its concerns about the difficulties logistics businesses and their workers had been facing accessing lateral flow tests (LFTs), which DTT raised with the Department of Health and Social Care (DHSC).

Four new Clean Air Zones to be introduced in 2022

Four Clean Air Zones (CAZs) are scheduled to be introduced in English cites in 2022 – Greater Manchester, Bradford, Bristol and Sheffeld. These will join cites where CAZs and Low Emission Zones (LEZs) are already in operation – London, Birmingham, Bath and Portsmouth. However, Bradford's CAZ, which was scheduled to begin operation in January 2022, is now not expected to be launched until early summer. The Greater Manchester CAZ may also be delayed.

Highway Code changes informed by Logistics UK



Logistics UK has been engaging closely with the review of the Highway Code, through consultation responses and meetings with officials from the Department for Transport (DfT), since 2020.

In its response to the consultation on these proposals affecting vulnerable road users, Logistics UK raised its concerns about the presumed liability rading from the new Hierarchy of Users' rule and about cyclisis passing large vehicles to the left. However, DT has listened carefully to the business group's concerns and has amended the guidance accordingly.
