

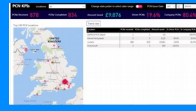

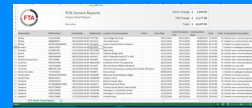

Logistics UK PCN Service - Process



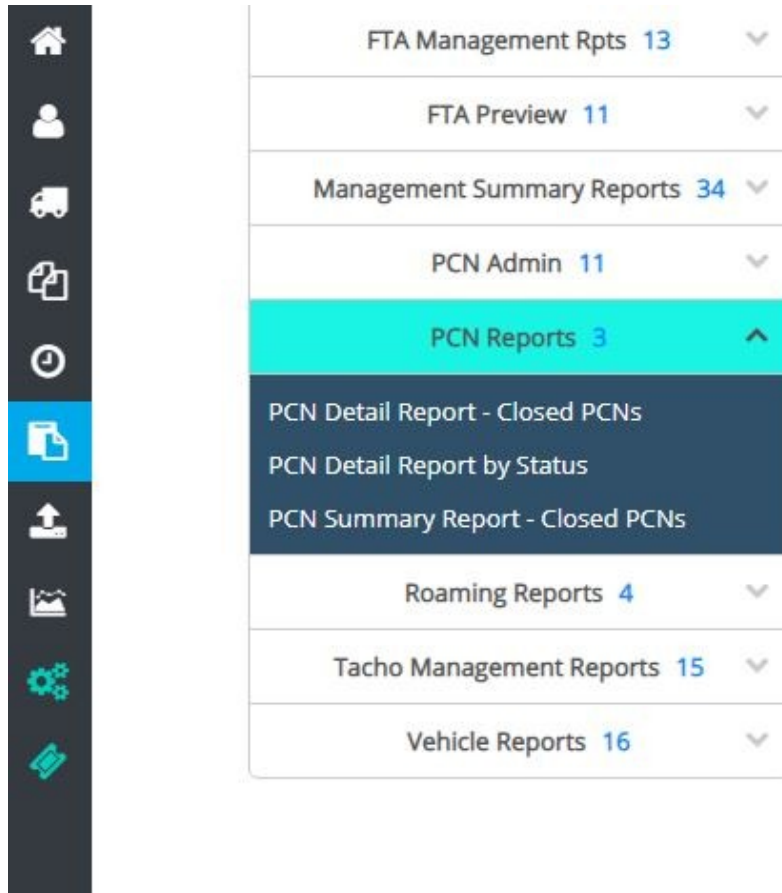
- PCNs sent to a central Logistics UK point direct from depots.
- PCNs are entered by Logistics UK onto central database within 48 hours.
- Logistics UK investigation areas include:
 - ✓ Loading restrictions
 - ✓ Dispensations
 - ✓ Appeal, bespoke appeals
 - ✓ Paying at discounted rate
 - ✓ Liaising with Local Authorities on behalf of the company

Logistics UK PCN Service - Process



- PCNs paid on Logistics UK company credit card. Closed PCNs and admin fee are charged on a monthly invoice with invoice breakdown report.
- Service can be set up quickly and dependent on PCN volumes you can start using the service within a short time.

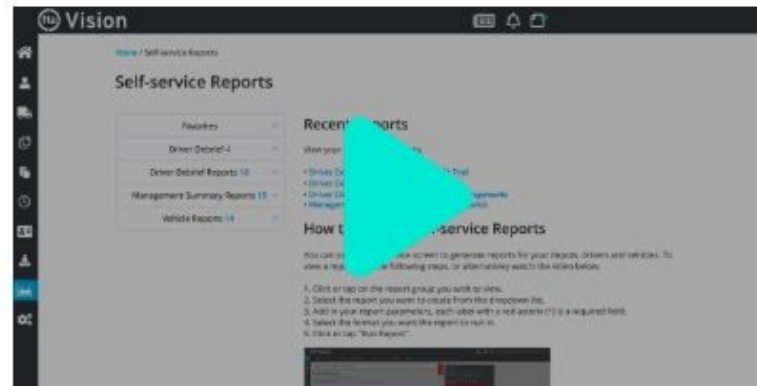
PCN Self Service Reports – available through Vision



How to use the self-service reports

You can use the self-service screen to generate reports for you depots, drivers and vehicles. To view a report take the following steps, or alternatively watch the video below.

1. Click or tap on the report group you wish to view
2. Select the report you want to create from the dropdown menu
3. Add in your report parameters, each label with a red asterisk (*) is a required field
4. Select the format you want the report to run in
5. Click or tap "Run report"

If you take both Logistics UK tachograph analysis and PCN administration services, and either the driver card or the vehicle unit data has been uploaded that covers the date and time that the contravention occurred, then the driver name will automatically be displayed on the PCN and will be reflected by displaying an icon on the both the vehicle and driver calendar, as well as showing the driver name on the PCN detail. It is possible to manually enter the drivers name here.

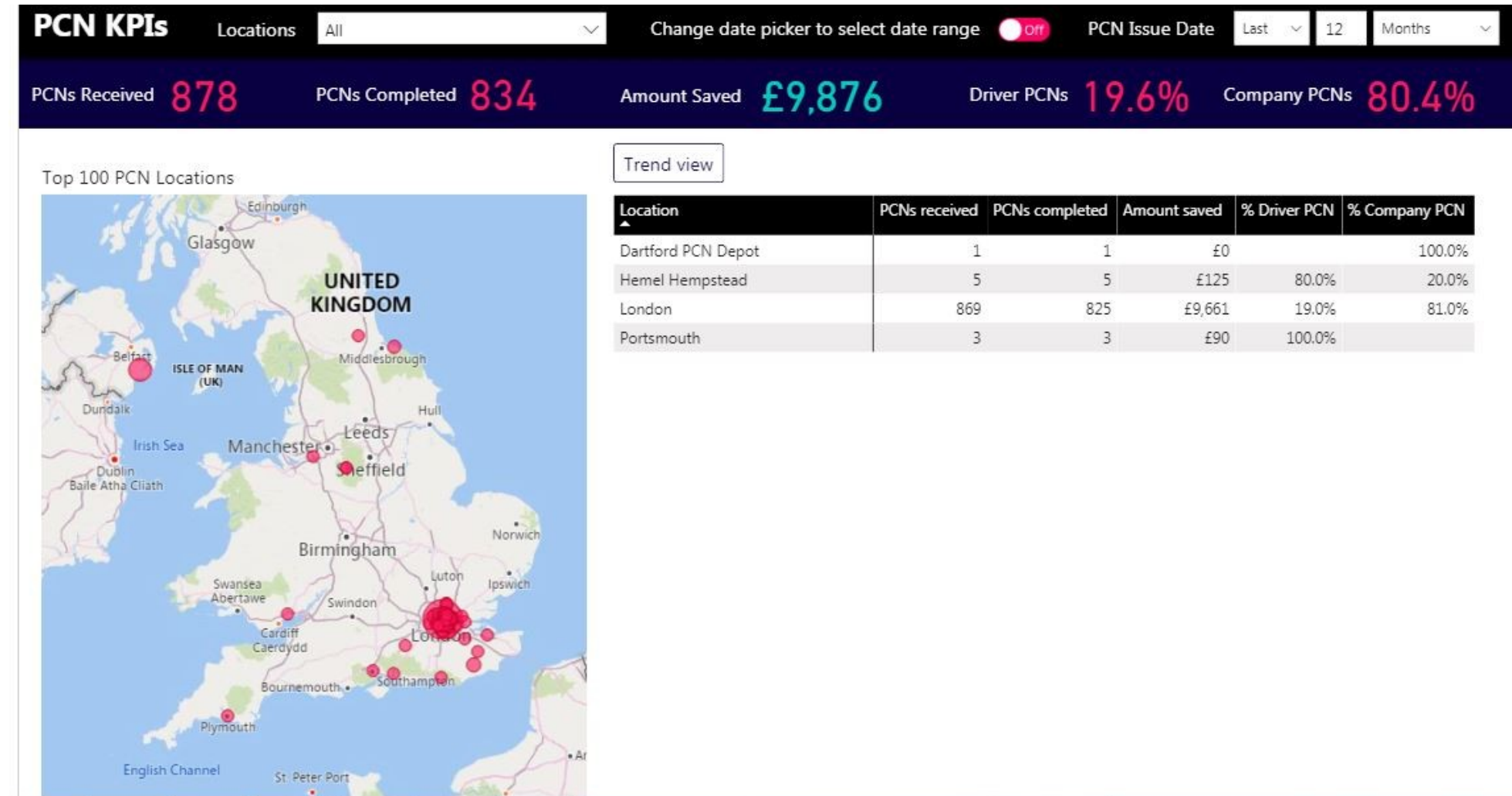

What is Logistics UK doing to help?

- Logistics UK sits on various groups and forums including:
 - TfL Freight Forum
 - TfL kerbside access and PCN working group
 - Central London Freight Quality Partnership
 - London Chamber of Commerce Transport Committee
 - British Parking Association Parking Forum
 - British Parking Association Approved Operator Scheme Board (parking enforcement on private land)

Through its campaign work, Logistics UK PCN team is ultimately working to reduce the number of PCN's issued to our members. We are working closely with the London business community to ensure that the essential role freight plays in underpinning the capital's economy is understood. We are actively lobbying the main issuing authorities and key politicians to ensure that adequate provision is made for loading/unloading; enforcement is reasonable and proportionate; and that the industry is not seen as a soft target for raising revenue.
