



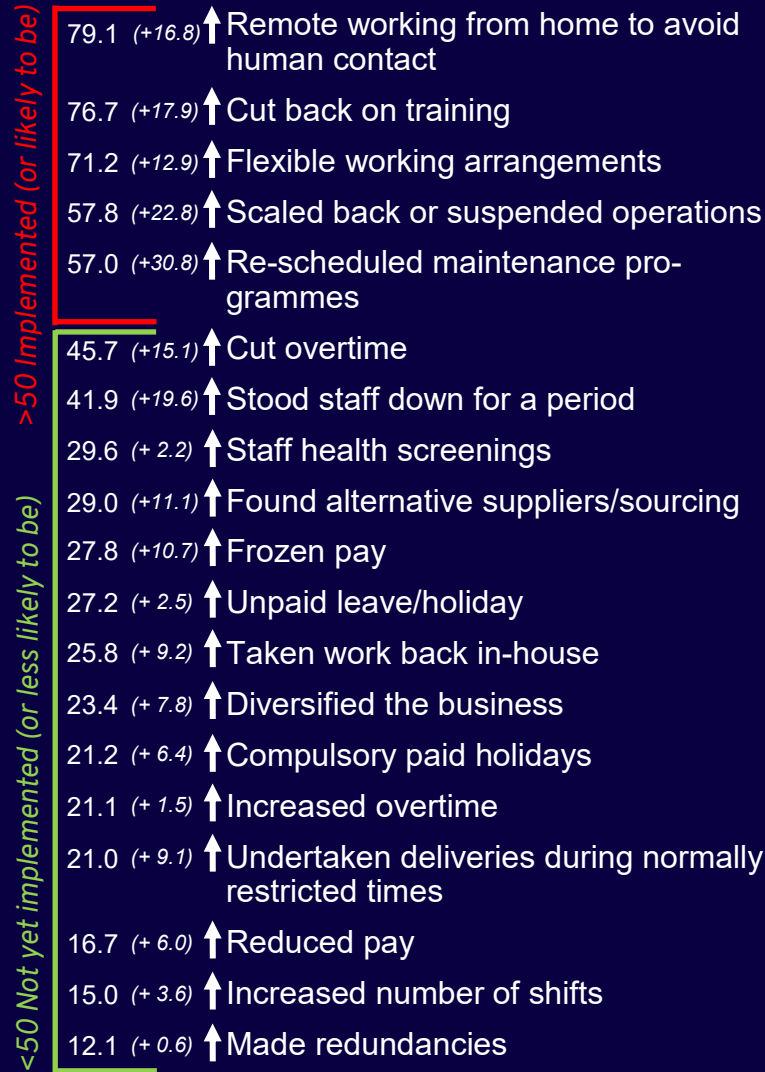
# Coronavirus Logistics Impact Survey: 27 March 2020

FTA's weekly Coronavirus Logistics Impact Survey focuses on identifying how operators and purchasers of logistics transport services are dealing with the coronavirus pandemic.

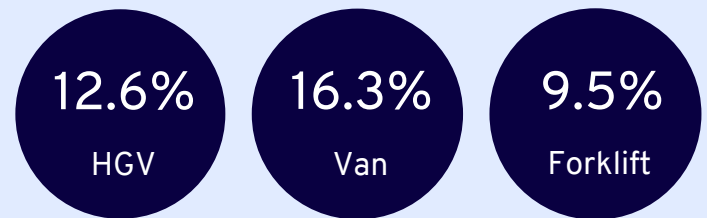
This second survey, conducted between 24 and 26 March 2020, had **425** respondents spanning over **18** sectors in the UK – **37%** were small businesses with less than 50 employees, while **over one-third** were large businesses with more than 250 staff. The majority (**94%**) were concerned with domestic trade while around **a third** were also involved in importing and/or exporting. **60%** were operators of logistics transport services, with just **under one-third** being both operators and users of logistics transport services.

Index (change – compared to last week)



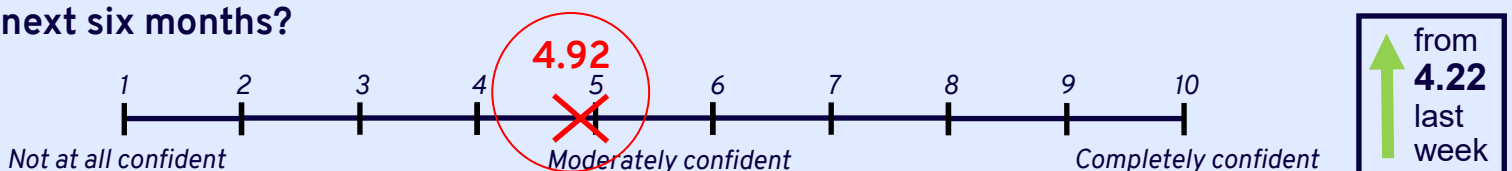

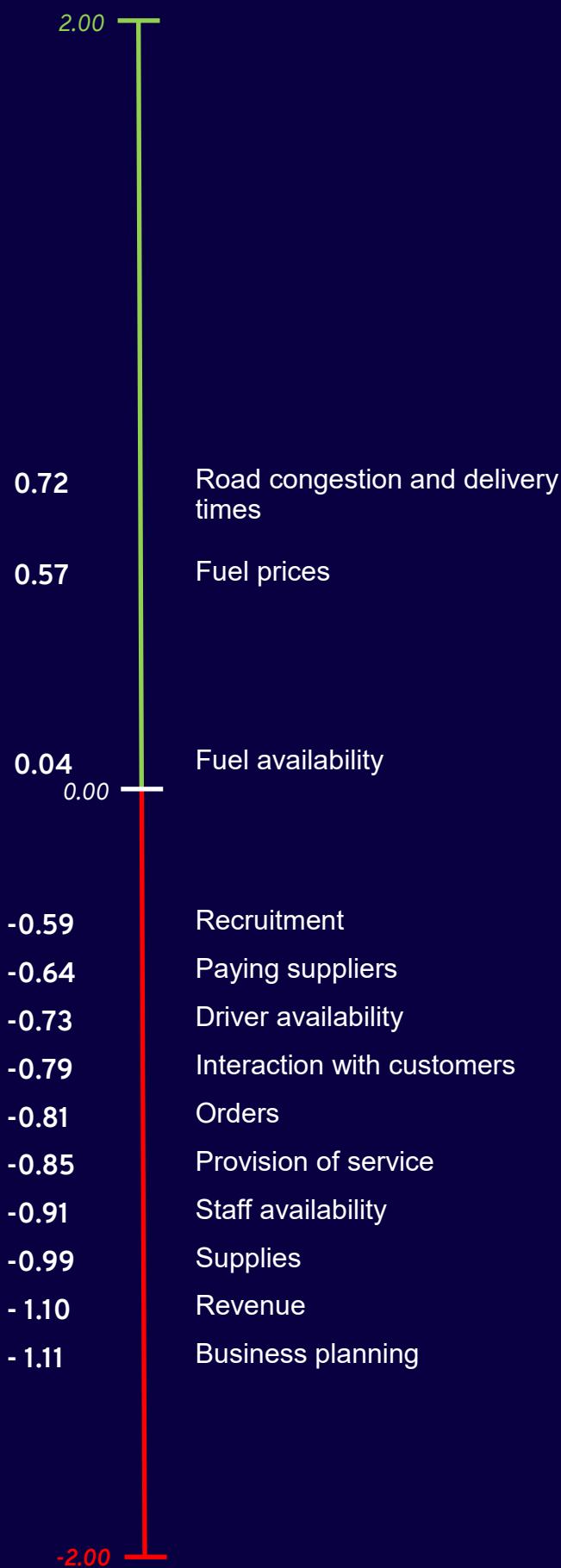


## How confident do businesses feel about the business outlook for their company in the next six months?

-2 = negative impact    0 = no impact    2 = positive impact

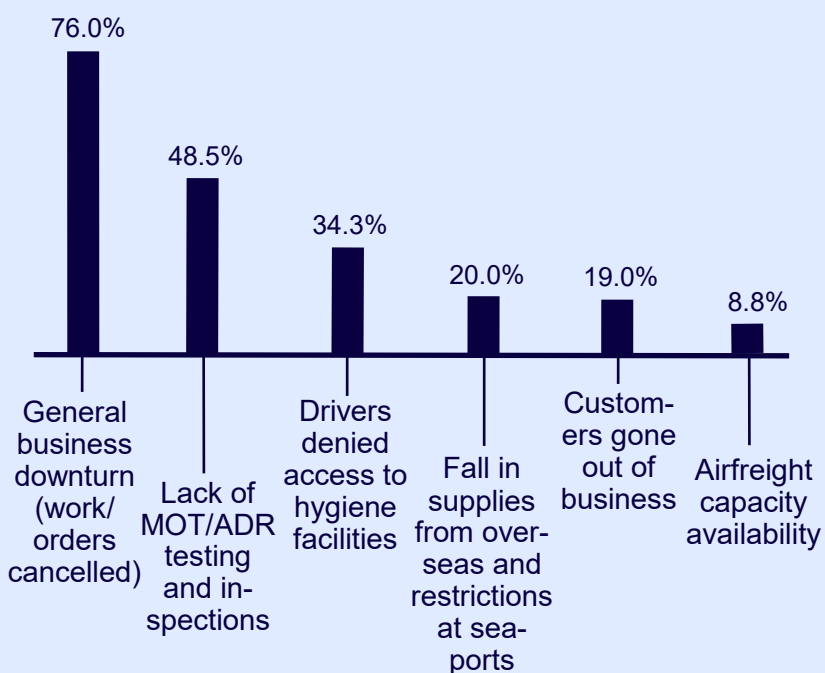


## Availability of supplies (compared to last week):
