Why do operators need to check drivers' licences?

The legal minimum requirement in the UK is for the driver of a vehicle to hold a full and valid driving licence for that vehicle category and for a vocational driver a valid Certificate of Professional Competence. If this driver is an employee or contractor and driving on company time, for business purposes, employers have a duty of care to ensure that the employee acts within the law. This means having a robust procedure and audit trail for driver licence checks.

This duty of care extends to full and part time staff, as well as any temporary drivers and contractors and covers all vehicles driven including heavy goods vehicles, vans and cars (even if the vehicle is their own, but driven for business purposes, on company time).




What could happen if these checks are not carried out correctly?

There is a range of legislation that covers the need for checking your drivers' licences which include the Health and Safety at Work Act, the Immigration, Asylum and Nationality Act 2006, the Corporate Manslaughter Act and the Road Traffic Act 1988. Failing to comply with these laws can lead to fines and, in the worst case, the loss of your operator licence and even imprisonment.

Our Driving Licence Verification service has been developed by TTC (formerly Licence Bureau). With over 1,000,000 licence checks each year, TTC's integrated technology platform Continuum, supports organisations with automated driving licence verification, ensuring compliance and helping members to identify issues quickly.

Integration with our Vision platform also makes licence check information and alerts viewable from each driver's tachograph record.

Risk Assessments

Every year, on average 1,700 people will lose their lives and another 27,000 people will receive a life changing serious injury because of a road traffic collision, up to a third of which occur when they are travelling for work. Typically, 95% of all collisions are due to human error, often due to lack of effective observation resulting in ill-informed decisions.

Optional online driver risk assessments identify individual driver's area of risk and mitigate via the provision of accessible, time efficient, risk specific online learning,

This preventative approach aims to ensure all drivers and their employers are armed with the appropriate knowledge and information to be as safe as possible.

Driver knowledge: Highway Code, motoring matters and hazard perception

Driver risk scoring is weighted appropriately to identify areas of highest risk. The scoring standards have been informed by three decades of experience in delivering driving learning and development, attending and investigating the causes of road traffic collisions and is supported by academic evidence and government statistics.





Grey Fleet Management

There are an estimated 14 million grey fleet vehicles on UK roads. If just one in three businesses regularly checking their grey fleet has appropriate insurance, tax and MOT, TTC's recent research suggests, this means more than 9 million grey fleet drivers are not routinely compliance checked.

In addition, one in five grey fleet checks currently processed by TTC result in failure. Nine in 10 of these failures occur due to lack of appropriate insurance cover for driving private vehicles for work purposes.

Grey fleet checks ensure Logistics UK members meet legal and duty of care obligations for any driver in their organisation who uses their own vehicle to travel for business.
