

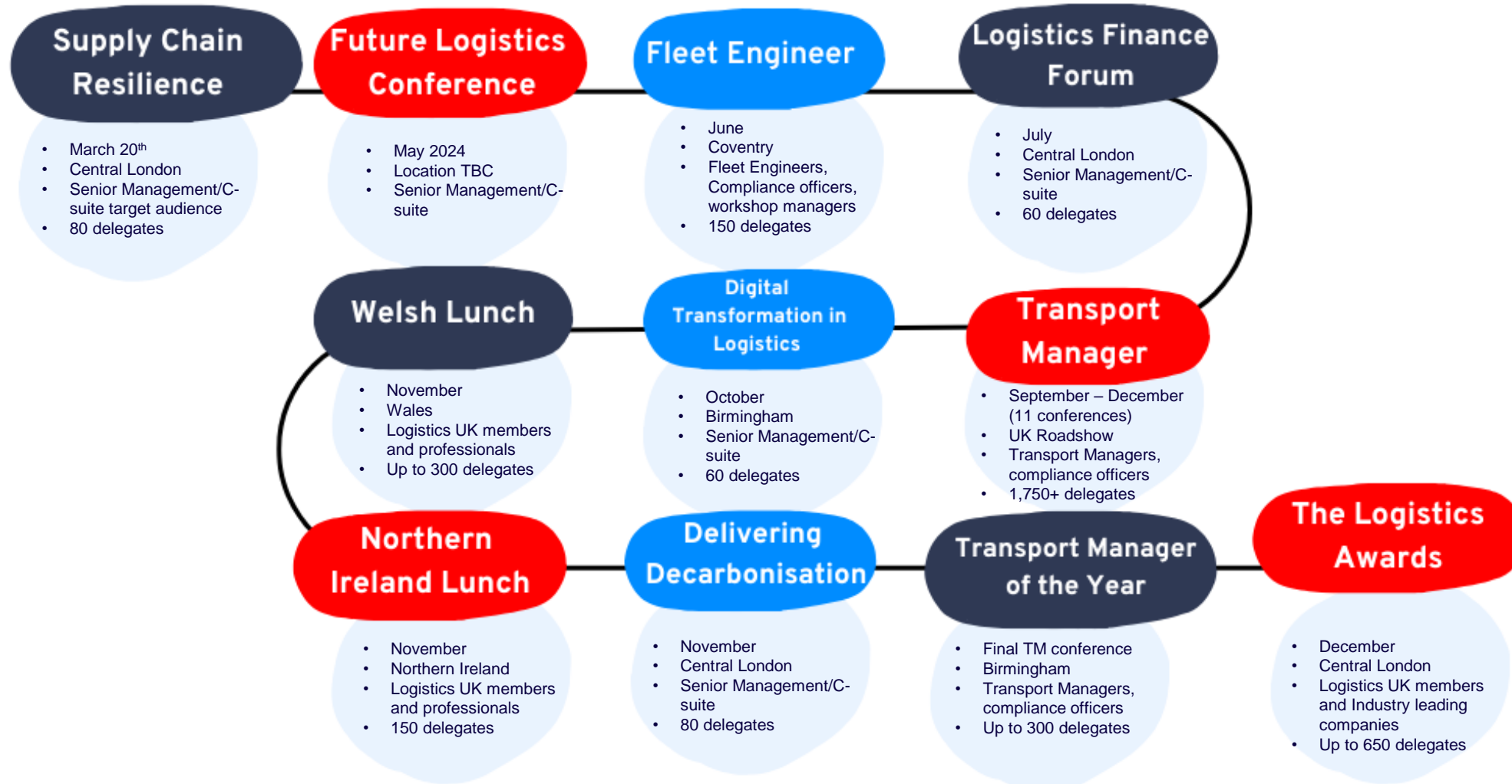

Who are we?

Logistics UK supports, shapes and stands-up for safe and efficient logistics. Logistics UK is one of the biggest business groups in the UK and are the only organisation in the UK that represents all of logistics.

As champions and challengers, Logistics UK speaks to Government with one voice on behalf of the whole sector, greatly increasing the impact of our messages and achieving amazing results for members.

- **Representation** – representing the business needs of the logistics industry to government at local, national and European level across road, rail, water and air, as well as the buyers of freight services such as retailers and manufacturers whose businesses depend on the efficient movement of goods.

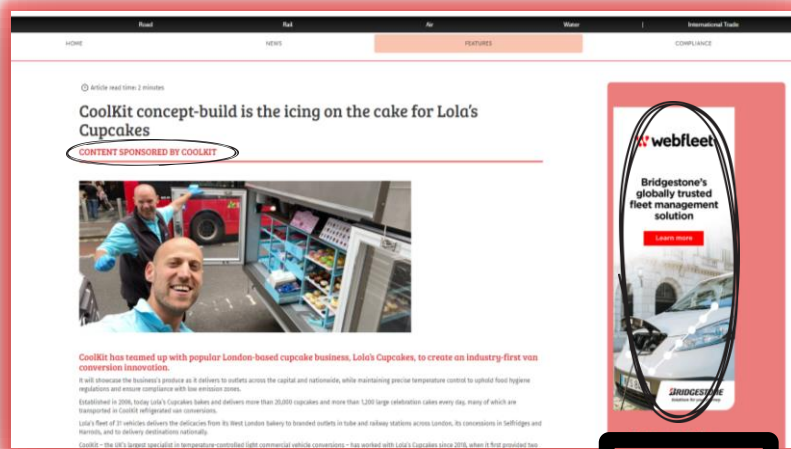

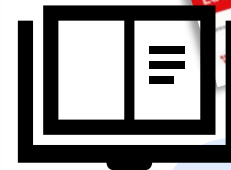
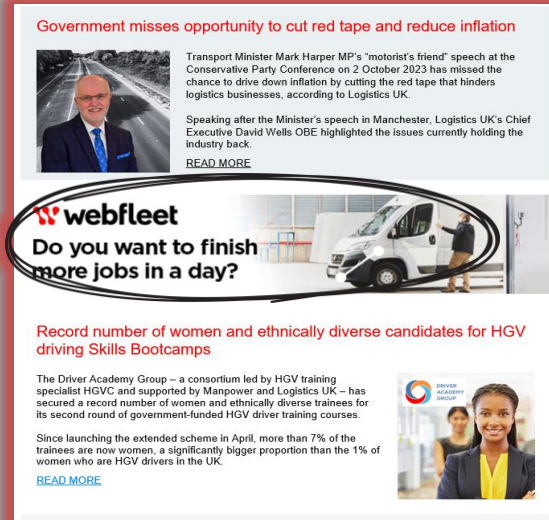


Logistics UK members consign **over 90% of rail freight** and **70% of UK exports by sea and air**

A snapshot of advertising opportunities



Logistics Magazine is a digital magazine distributed to 23,000 Logistics UK members and senior businesspeople. The weekly magazine is a vital and important aspect of Logistics UK membership.



Logistics Magazine is sent to Logistics UK's membership via an email newsletter, which acts as a summary and CTA to visit the online portal. There are opportunities to host banner adverts and have sponsored editorial on the newsletter and portal. [Click here](#) to view the portal; banners are booked on a weekly basis and sponsored posts remain on the site for up to 18 months.



In addition to the weekly digital magazine, Logistics UK also produces quarterly publications under specific themes. There is the opportunity to become a sponsor of these publications, which includes having a company logo on the front cover, a 'sponsor's message', a full-page advert and a full-page editorial. These publications are also sent to the entire membership, as well as posted on social media and printed between 200 and 2,000 times, depending on the opportunity to distribute.
